During Pregnancy



Respect

You will get the information and help you need to make your own choices about feeding your baby. Your choice will be supported.

Helpful Conversations

During your pregnancy, we'll make sure you feel confident and ready to feed your baby. We will teach you the skills you need.

Birth & First Days



Skin-to-Skin Time

Right after birth, your baby will rest on your bare chest for at least an hour. This helps your baby feel safe and is great for bonding.

Expert Care

Doctors and nurses at Baby-Friendly hospitals receive extra training to help you with feeding your baby.

Throughout Your Stay



Staying in the Same Room

Your baby will stay in your hospital room with you. This helps you bond, learn your baby's feeding cues, and respond to their needs.

Help with Breastfeeding

If you choose to breastfeed, trained nurses will help you learn how.

Formula information

You'll learn how to safely prepare and feed formula if needed.
